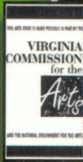
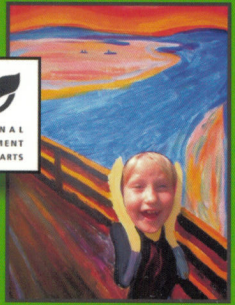

History

The Galax-Carroll-Grayson area of Southwestern Virginia boasts a variety of artistic expression such as, theatre groups, community chorus, a folk society, and a thriving traditional music organization. Our community is the proud home of countless artisans and musicians. In 1987 a dedicated group of individuals organized the Arts Council of the Twin Counties in response to, and in appreciation of this rich heritage.

Mission

The members and board of the Arts Council believe that art is important to the life of a community and nourishes human development. Our purpose is threefold:

1. To promote communication, cooperation and mutual support of the arts in the Twin Counties.
2. To serve as a liaison between the arts and businesses, government and educational institutes.
3. To provide educational services for and about the arts. We carry out this mission through classes for adults and children, lectures, and performances. A Carmichael Scholarship is presented annually to graduating seniors from each of the local high schools who are pursuing Studies in the fine arts.
